Weather Brief for Monday, 28 October 2024 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Monday, 28 October 2024 were available for most of the stations. **Kumaka Region 01 recorded the highest rainfall of 22.9 mm.**

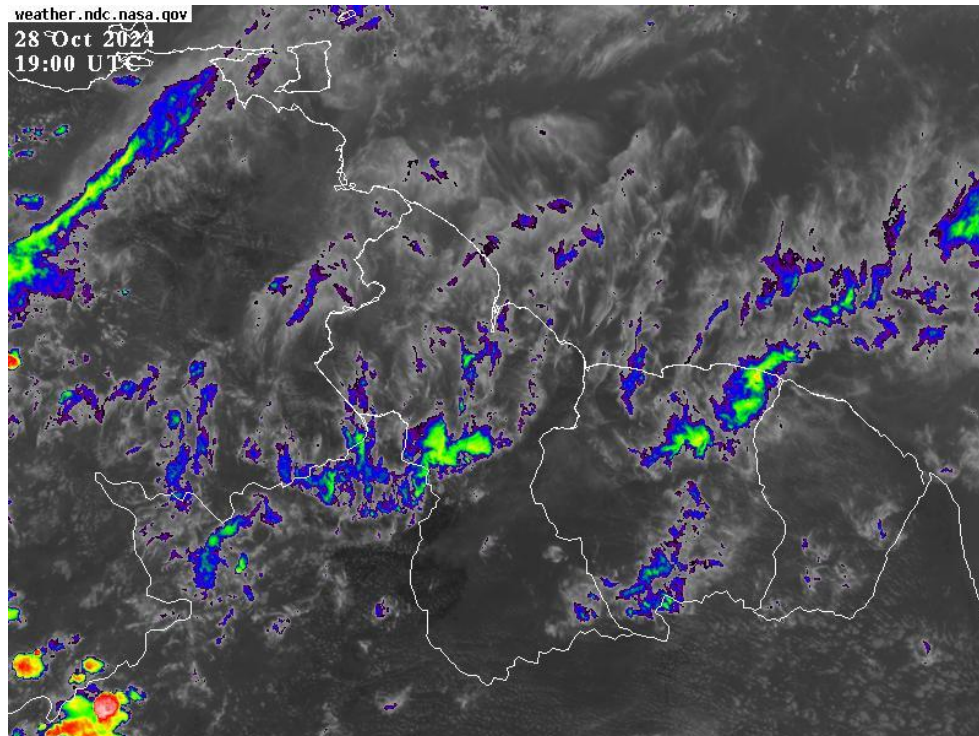
Synopsis: Weak instabilities are affecting Guyana.

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Sea conditions:

Moderate in open waters with swells reaching 1.0 to 2.0 meters (3 to 5 ft) and increasing.

-These waves will likely have periods of between 9 and 10 seconds.

- Moderate easterly winds.

Extended Forecast

Wednesday to Sunday: Mix of sunshine and clouds with brief afternoon cloudiness and possible passing showers. **No significant rainfall is anticipated.**
