**Weather Brief for Thursday, 31 October 2024 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana.**



Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Thursday, 31 October 2024 were available for most of the stations.

**Kairuni in Region 4 recorded the highest rainfall of 8.9 mm.**

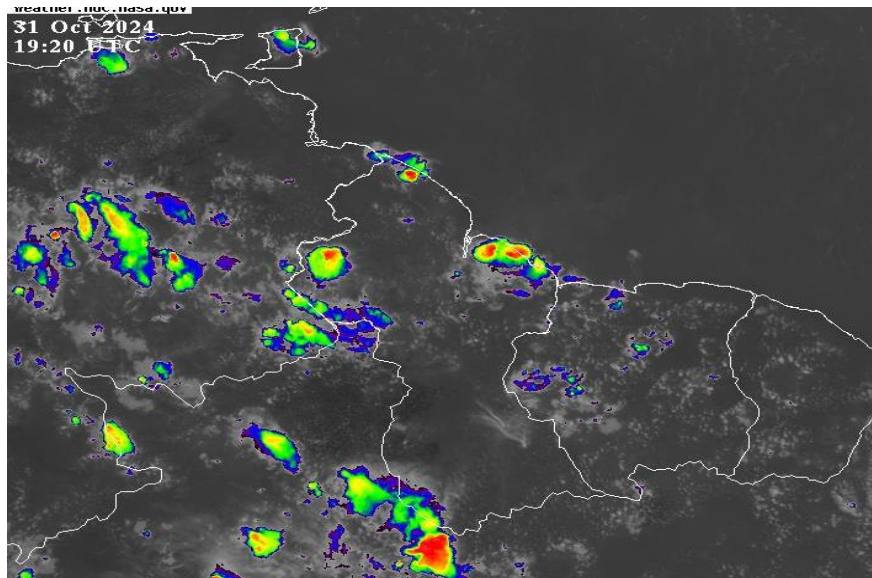
Synopsis: Weak to moderate isolated instabilities are affecting areas of regions 3 to 5. Elsewhere, subsidence and ridging remain dominant.

Today's weather review: Thundershowers were observed over regions 3 to 5 in the early afternoon. Elsewhere, fair and sunny skies.

Extended Forecast

Saturday and Sunday: Mostly cloudy skies with scattered to occasional showers and isolated thundershowers can be expected. **Rainfall is anticipated between 10 to 30 mm within 24 hours of accumulations.**

Monday to Wednesday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies can be expected with scattered showers. **Rainfall is expected between 0 to 15 mm within 24 hours of accumulations.**
