SEVERE WEATHER WARNINGS: In areas of thundershowers, lightning strikes and heavy winds may be observed.

<u>MARINE ADVISORY</u>: Long-period and high-energy waves coupled with spring tides will likely result in overtopping and damage to river and sea defences in vulnerable areas. Persons residing in riverine and low-lying areas are asked to be alert and exercise all caution in efforts to safeguard life and property during this time.

SPRING TIDE ADVISORY: Persons are advised that the spring tide Advisory will become effective from tomorrow morning and will continue until Saturday, October 11, 2025.

Weather Brief for Monday, 06 October 2025 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana. Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Monday, 06 October 2025 were available for most of the stations. Fort Island in region 3 recorded the highest rainfall of 52.0mm.


<u>Synopsis:</u> Weak instabilities driven by daytime heating are affecting Guyana. Model forecast skies a series of induced troughing expected for the remainder of the week, in addition to occasions of the ITCZ oscillation.

<u>Today's weather review</u>: Isolated showers and thundershowers were observed across Guyana.

Extended Forecast

<u>Wednesday to Sunday:</u> Mostly cloudy skies with intermittent to frequent showers, with thundershowers across Guyana. Rainfall intensities are expected to be moderate to heavy in the early morning and late afternoon into the evening. Otherwise, expect light to moderate downpours. Rainfall is anticipated to be between 30 to 60 mm within 24 hours of accumulation.
