**SEVERE WEATHER WARNINGS:** In areas of thundershowers, lightning strikes and heavy winds may be observed.

**MARINE ADVISORY:** High-energy waves coupled with spring tides will likely result in overtopping and damage to river and sea defences in vulnerable areas. Persons residing in riverine and low-lying areas are asked to be alert and exercise all caution in efforts to safeguard life and property during this time.

**SPRING TIDE ADVISORY:** Persons are advised that the spring tide Advisory will become effective from tomorrow morning and will continue until Saturday, October 11, 2025.

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Thursday, 09 October 2025 were available for most of the stations.

**North Yakusari in Region 6 recorded the highest rainfall of 70.9 mm.**

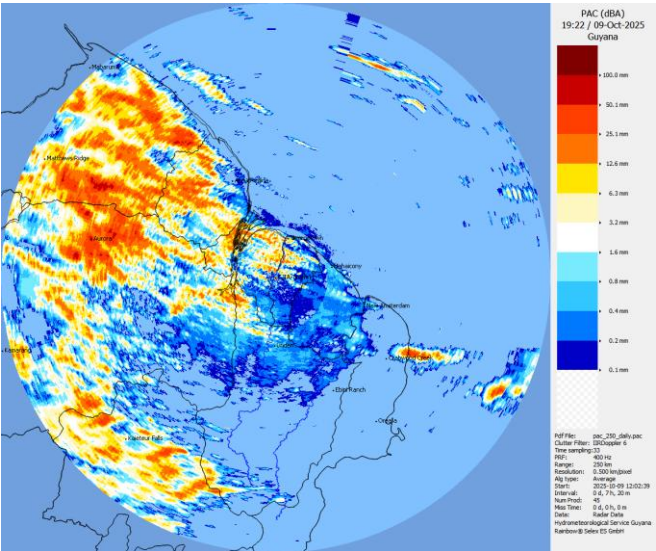
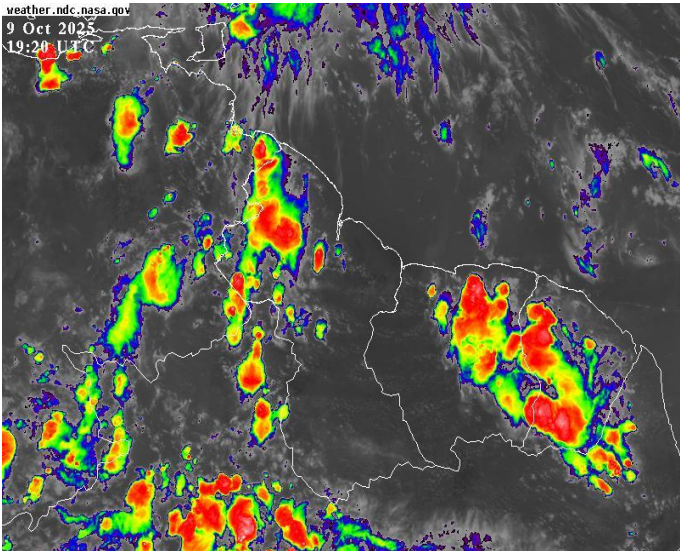
Synopsis: Strong low-level confluenting and moderate instabilities are affecting Guyana. This pattern is expected to continue over the week and into the new week.

### Sea conditions:

**Moderate to rough seas in open waters with northeast to easterly swells reaching 2.0 to 3.0 meters (6 to 8 ft) and increasing.**

- These waves will likely have periods of 8 and 9 seconds.
- Moderate easterly breeze.

## Extended Forecast

**Saturday to Wednesday:** Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered showers with thundershowers. Rainfall is anticipated to be between 10 and 25 mm within 24 hours of accumulation.
