WEATHER BRIEF for Sunday 07 September 2025, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana-
Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hours on Sunday, 07 September 2025, were available for some stations. Aishalton in Region 9 recorded the highest rainfall of 67.8mm.
Synopsis: No significant Synoptic feature in the forecast area. however, local convection is expected to generate Weak to moderate instabilities in some areas.
Weather review: Mostly sunny skies were interrupted by scattered showers in Region 10 and inland areas of Regions 1 to 3

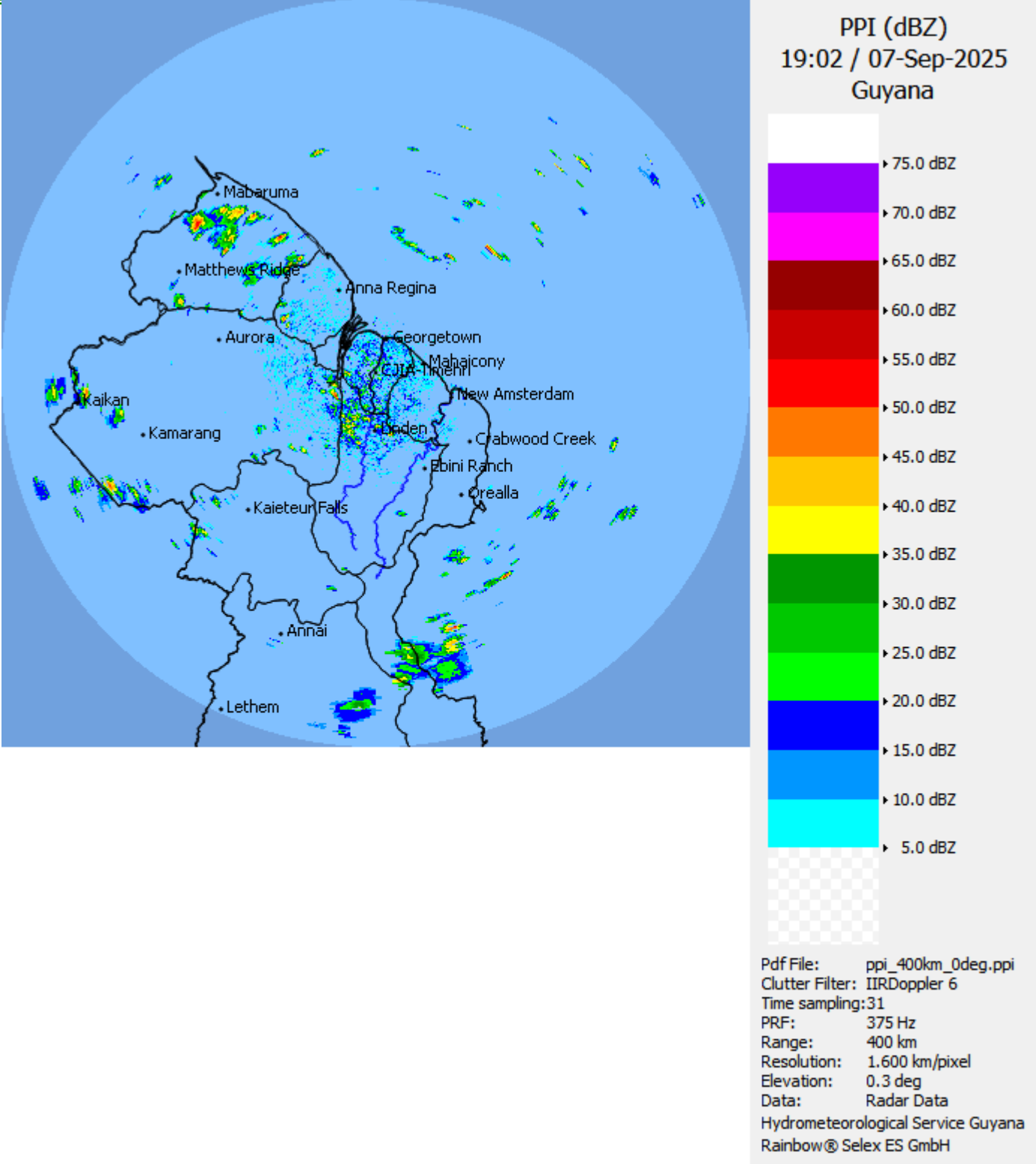
