Weather Brief for Saturday, 07 February 2026 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Saturday, 07 February 2026 were available for most of the stations. **West Watooka in Region 10 recorded the highest rainfall of 5.2 mm.**

Marine Advisory: High-energy waves will likely cause damage to river and sea defences. All marine users should remain on high alert, and persons living in low-lying coastal and riverine areas should take all necessary precautions.



Synopsis: A prevailing stable atmospheric pattern dominates much of Guyana today; however, in the southern regions, southerly moisture advection produced some weak instabilities, but nevertheless, no significant rainfall amounts. SAL, Subsidence and ridge conditions continue to suppress widespread instability, resulting in mainly stable conditions across coastal and interior areas.

Today's weather review: Except for partly cloudy to cloudy skies with brief showers observed over southern regions 6 and 9, elsewhere, mainly fair and sunny skies dominated.

Spring Tide Advisory: The spring tide is not in effect.

Sea conditions:

Slight to moderate in open waters with north to northeast waves reaching 1.0 to 1.5 meters (4 to 6 ft) and steady.

- These waves will likely have periods of 9 and 12 seconds
- Gentle east to southeast breeze.

Extended Forecast

Monday: Morning cloudy spells with scattered showers over coastal Guyana, elsewhere, cloudy in the afternoon with occasional showers. **Rainfall is expected between 5 mm and 20 mm within 24 hours.**

Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday: Mostly fair and sunny skies with a few passing showers are likely to prevail across Guyana. **Rainfall is expected between 0 mm and 5 mm within 24 hours.**

Thursday: Cloudy skies with intermittent rain and thundershowers are likely across Guyana. **Rainfall is expected between 20 mm and 45 mm within 24 hours.**
