**Weather Brief for Saturday, 30 November 2024 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana**





Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Saturday, 30 November 2024 were available for most of the stations. **White Water in Region 1 recorded the highest rainfall of 13.1 mm.**

**Marine Advisory: Moderate to rough seas with high energy waves will likely cause damage and possible overtopping of sea defense. Scattered showers. People are asked to take the necessary precautions.**

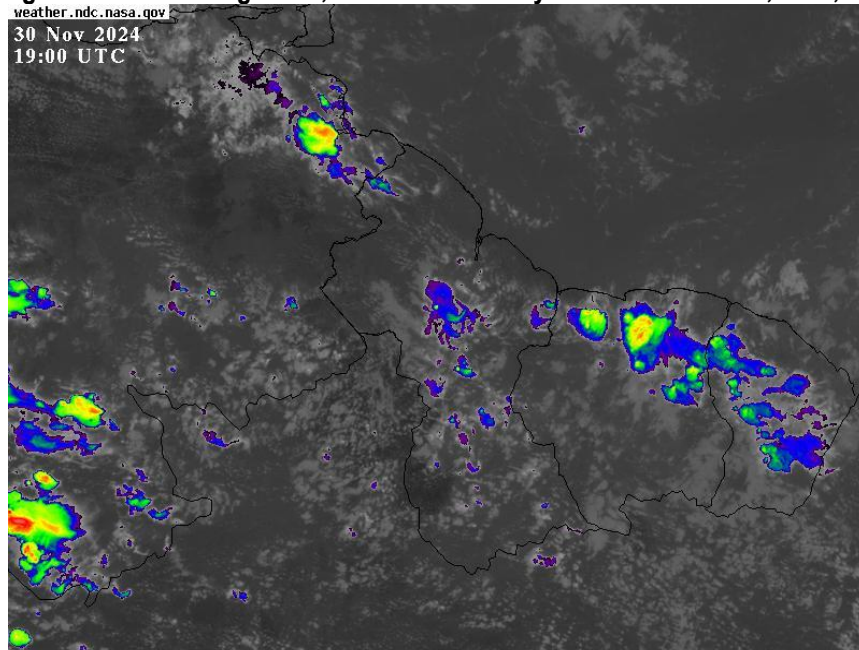
**Synopsis:** High concentrations of SAL and mid-upper-level subsistence produced mainly stable conditions along coastal regions, while surface-low-level systems with very high moisture produce weak to moderate instabilities over inland and southern regions in the afternoon into the evening.

**Today's weather review:** Coastal regions observed partly cloudy and sunny skies with isolated showers. All other regions observed partly cloudy and sunny skies becoming cloudy in the afternoon with occasional light to moderate showers and isolated thundershowers.

**Spring Tide Advisory:** The spring tide is not in effect.

**Sea conditions:**

- Moderate to rough seas from the northeast with swells reaching 2.5 to 3.0 meters in open waters.
- These waves will likely have periods of between 12 and 14 seconds.
- Gentle to moderate breeze from the east.

**Extended Forecast**

**Monday:** Cloudy skies with intermittent rain and thundershowers are likely over southern parts of region 1, regions 4 to Northern 6, 7, 8, and 10. All other regions can expect partly cloudy skies with scattered showers. Rainfall is expected between 20 and 45 mm over southern parts of region 1, regions 4 to Northern 6, 7, 8, and 10, and Remaining regions between 5 and 15 mm within 24 hours.

**Tuesday:** Cloudy skies with intermittent rain and thundershowers are likely over regions 2 to 8, and 10. All other regions can expect partly cloudy skies with scattered showers. Rainfall is expected between 20 and 45 mm over regions 2 to 8, and 10, and Remaining regions between 5 and 15 mm within 24 hours.

**Wednesday through Friday:** Partly cloudy and sunny skies with brief showers. Rainfall is expected between 0 and 10 mm within 24 hours.
