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Severe Weather Advisory	The potential of flooding over low lying areas and areas over Southern Guyana remains high as rainfall is expected to continue.
Marine Advisory 	Citizens are advised that the spring tide advisory is in effect. Residents of low-lying, riverine, and flood-prone areas are advised to take the necessary precautions against flooding as over-topping is likely.
Weather Synopsis	Low level troughs continue to propagate over Guyana and are enhancing the potential for convection over most of the Administrative Regions. Strong plumes of moisture embedded within these low-level troughs are also observed. This pattern is expected to continue for the next 12 hours.
Observed Conditions	Cloudy skies with scattered showers were observed over most of Guyana.
Weather Forecast 07:00 pm – 07:00 am	Mostly cloudy to overcast skies with widespread showers of varying intensities and frequent rain are likely to be experienced over Regions 1 to 10. Isolated thundershowers are also likely over Regions 1, 2, 6 to 9. Rainfall is expected to range between 20.0 mm and 50.0 mm. Winds: Gentle to moderate Easterly breeze. Gusting in areas with thundershowers. Temperature: Coastal areas (22 to 25) °C and the remaining areas (19 to 22) °C
Tides	Low Tide will be at 21:33 hrs at a height of 0.66 meter. High Tide will be at 03:53 hrs at a height of 2.94 meters.
Spring Tides Advisory	Persons are reminded that the spring tide advisory is in effect.
Sea Conditions	Moderate seas in open waters with Easterly swells reaching 1.5 to 2.0 meters (5 to 6ft) and steady. -These waves will likely have periods of between 7 and 8 seconds. - Moderate Northeasterly to Easterly breeze.
