**WEATHER BRIEF for Thursday, 04 April 2024, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana**

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Thursday, April 4, 2024, were available for most stations.

**No 4 Backdam in Region 5 recorded the highest rainfall of 19.0 mm.**

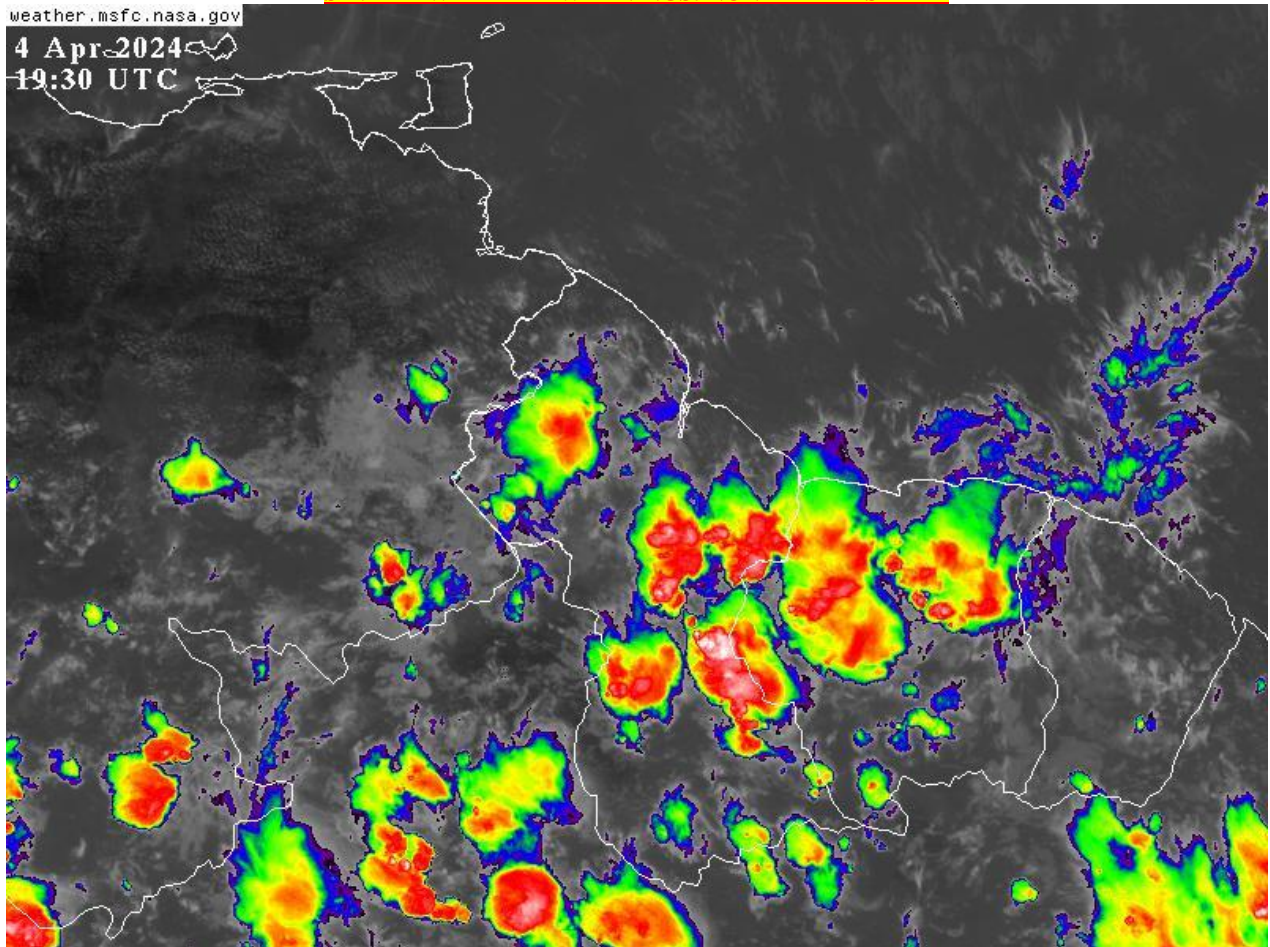
**Synopsis:** Increased moisture produced weak instabilities over parts of the forecast area.
