## WEATHER BRIEF for Thursday, 04 April 2024, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Thursday, April 4, 2024, were available for most stations.


No 4 Backdam in Region 5 recorded the highest rainfall of 19.0 mm.

Synopsis: Increased moisture produced weak instabilities over parts of the forecast area.

<u>Today's weather review</u>: Mainly cloudy skies were seen across Guyana today with scattered light to moderate showers.
