
### <u>WEATHER BRIEF for Sunday, 07 April 2024, from the Hydrometeorological Service,</u> <u>Guyana</u>

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Sunday, April 7, 2024, were available for most stations. Charity in region 2 recorded the highest rainfall of 20.0 mm.

<u>Synopsis:</u> Ridging and subsidence throughout most levels of the atmosphere dominated producing mainly stable conditions. <u>Today's weather review</u>: Mostly fair and sunny skies were seen across Guyana.
