WEATHER BRIEF for Sunday, 07 April 2024, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Sunday, April 7, 2024, were available for most stations.

Charity in region 2 recorded the highest rainfall of 20.0 mm.

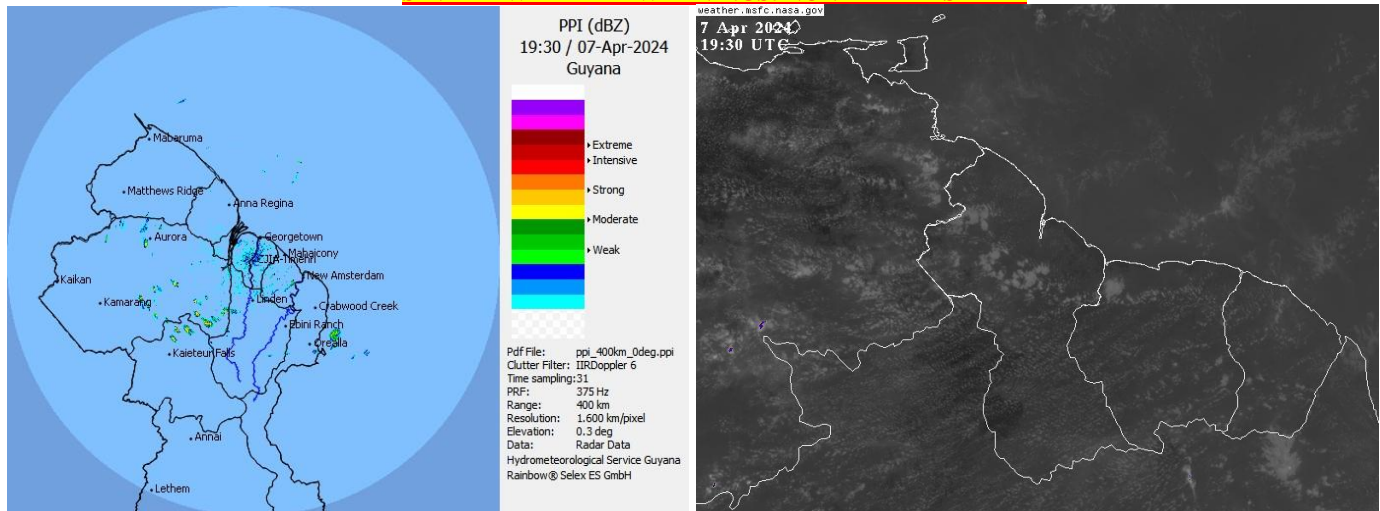
Synopsis: Ridging and subsidence throughout most levels of the atmosphere dominated producing mainly stable conditions.

SPRING TIDE ADVISORY: CITIZENS ARE ADVISED THAT THE SPRING TIDE ADVISORY is IN EFFECT AND WILL CONTINUE UNTIL SATURDAY 13TH APRIL 2024.

Sea conditions: MODERATE SEAS WITH NORTHEAST TO EASTERLY SWELLS REACHING HEIGHTS OF 2.0 TO 2.5 METERS (7 TO 8 FT) AND DECREASING. THESE WAVES ARE LIKELY TO HAVE PERIODS OF BETWEEN 12 S AND 14 S. GENTLE NORTHEASTERLY TO EASTERLY BREEZE.
