Weather Brief for Tuesday, 02 April 2024 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Tuesday, 02 April 2024 were available for most of the stations **Matthews Ridge in Region 1 recorded the highest rainfall of 30.0 mm**

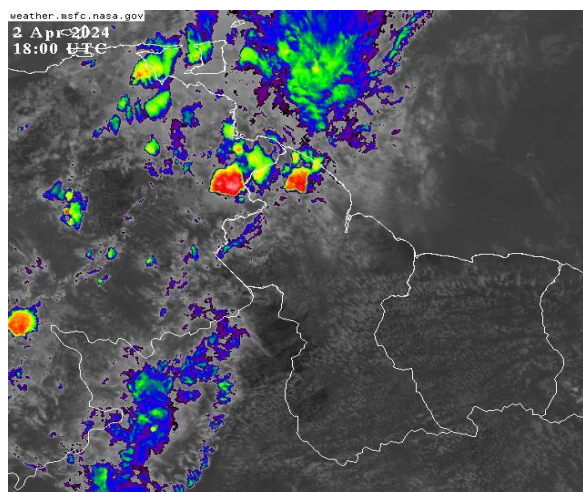
Synopsis: Weak instabilities from a shear line continue to affect northwestern Region 1. All other areas continue to see strong subsidence and high-pressure ridges being dominant.

Today's weather review: Cloudy skies with thundershowers over region 1, elsewhere, sunny skies with a mix of clouds.

Extended Forecast

Thursday: Mainly cloudy skies throughout Guyana with scattered to occasional showers. Rainfall is expected between 5 to 20 mm.

Friday, early morning cloudy skies with occasional to frequent showers during the early morning hours. Sunny skies are expected from mid-morning. Rainfall is anticipated between 20 to 30 mm.

Saturday to Wednesday, mostly sunny with a mix of clouds and possible light isolated showers. No significant rainfall is likely.
