## HYDROMETEOROLOGICAL SERVICE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE

### Weather Brief for Thursday, 25 April 2024 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Thursday, 25 April 2024 were available for most of the stations. Mahdia in Region 8 recorded the highest rainfall of 42.0 mm.

<u>Synopsis:</u> Low-level troughs continue to oscillate over southern Guyana producing unstable deep convective activity. Northern Guyana continues to see stable conditions with the influence of the High-pressure ridge and the presence of Saharan Dust.


<u>Today's weather review</u>: a mix of sunshine and clouds was observed over northern Guyana while southern Guyana saw mostly cloudy to overcast skies with showers and thundershowers.

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### Sea conditions:

Smooth to moderate in open water with swells ranging from 1.0 to 2.0 meters (3 to 5 ft) and increasing.

- These waves will likely have periods of between 7 and 11 seconds.
- a moderate easterly breeze.

#### **Extended Forecast**

<u>Saturday and Sunday:</u> Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with scattered showers and isolated afternoon thundershowers. Rainfall is expected between 0 to 15 mm within 24 hours of accumulations.

Monday and Tuesday, mostly cloudy to overcast skies can be expected throughout Guyana with occasional to frequent showers and isolated thundershowers. Rainfall is expected between 20 to 40 mm within 24 hours of accumulations. Wednesday, mostly overcast skies with intermittent to continuous showers and rain. Rainfall intensities are anticipated to be mostly moderate to heavy during mid-morning into mid-afternoon. Rainfall is anticipated between 50 to 80 mm within 24 hours of accumulations

Thursday, Sunny skies with a few cloudy periods and isolated showers. No significant rainfall is likely.
