WEATHER BRIEF for today Monday, 13 May 2024, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Monday, May 13, 2024, were available for most stations.

Sharima in Region 7 recorded the highest rainfall of 20.0 mm.


Severe Weather Warnings: Given that the soil may have already been saturated from heavy rainfall, the current and forecasted conditions will likely result in or continue to exacerbate flooding in low lying, and areas of poor drainage. In areas of thundershowers, heavy winds, and possible lightning strikes may be observed. Persons should exercise caution in efforts to safeguard life and property.

<u>Synopsis:</u> Generally stable conditions were observed over most of the forecast area. A decrease in atmospheric moisture coupled with surface ridging contributed to these conditions. Based on the latest model outputs, atmospheric moisture is expected to increase during the next 12 hours creating more unstable conditions, especially over Southern Guyana.

<u>Today's weather review</u>: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated showers were observed over Inland areas. All other areas observed partly cloudy to fair skies.

<u>Sea conditions:</u> SLIGHT TO MODERATE SEAS WITH NORTHEASTERLY SWELLS REACHING HEIGHTS OF 1.5 TO 2.0 METERS IN OPEN WATERS. THESE WAVES ARE LIKELY TO HAVE PERIODS OF BETWEEN 7 S AND 8 S. GENTLE TO MODERATE BREEZE FROM THE NORTHEAST TO EAST.

Extended Forecast

Wednesday thru Sunday: Cloudy skies with scattered showers of varying intensities and intermittent rain can be expected over Inland and Southern Guyana. Isolated thundershowers are likely to be experienced over Southern Guyana. Rainfall is expected between 25.0 mm and 50.0 mm within 24 hours over these areas. Cloudy skies with scattered showers varying mostly from light to moderate and intermittent rain can be expected over Coastal Guyana during the morning hours. Conditions are expected to improve from the afternoon hours as partly cloudy to cloudy skies will likely prevail. Rainfall will range between 5.0 mm and 25.0 mm within 24 hours
