Weather Brief for Thursday, 02 May 2024 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00hrs Thursday, 02 May 2024 were available for most of the stations Kumu in Region 9 recorded the highest rainfall of 15.2 mm.

Severe Weather Warnings: Lightning strikes and heavy winds may occur before and during thundershowers. Persons are asked to take precautions.


<u>Synopsis</u>: Weak troughs, confluencing, and localized conditions with high moisture from the lower levels of the atmosphere produce weak instabilities over the inland and southern regions of the forecast area during the afternoon. The remaining regions were dominated by ridging, subsidence, and mid-upper level wind shear and upper-level convergence, contributing to stable conditions. Dynamical models indicate similar conditions for the next 36 to 48 hours.

<u>Today's weather review</u>: Afternoon cloudy spells with scattered showers and isolated thundershowers were observed over inland and southern regions during the afternoon hours. All remaining regions observed partly cloudy and sunny skies with a few morning showers.

Sea conditions:

-Moderate seas from the north with swells reaching 2.0 to 2.5 meters in open waters.

-These waves will likely have periods of between 7 and 8 seconds.

-Moderate breeze from the east.

Extended Forecast

<u>Saturday:</u> Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with occasional showers and isolated thundershowers are likely over inland and southern regions. Rainfall is expected between 10 mm and 30 mm within 24 hours. All the remaining regions can expect partly cloudy and sunny skies with scattered morning showers. Rainfall is expected between 0 mm and 15 mm within 24 hours.

<u>Sunday through Monday</u>: Cloudy to overcast skies with intermittent to continuous rain and isolated thundershowers are likely across Guyana. Rainfall is expected between 30 mm and 70 mm within 24 hours.

<u>Tuesday and Wednesday</u>: Cloudy to overcast skies with frequent rain and scattered thundershowers are likely over inland and southern regions. Rainfall is expected between 20 mm and 50 mm within 24 hours. All the remaining regions can expect partly cloudy to cloudy skies with occasional to frequent showers. Rainfall is expected between 5 mm and 20 mm within 24 hours.
