Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Friday, 03 May 2024 were available for most of the stations. Richmond Hill in Region 3 and Cane Grove Front in Region 4 recorded the highest rainfall of 97.4 mm.


Synopsis: Strong confluence and low-level troughs are affecting Guyana.

Extended Forecast

Sunday: Overcast skies with moderate to heavy thundershowers and rain during the morning hours. Rainfall is anticipated between 70 to 80 mm.

Monday to Thursday, Regions 6 to 10 will see cloudy to overcast skies with moderate to heavy intermittent to continuous rain and thundershowers. Rainfall is anticipated between 60 to 80 mm within 24 hours of accumulations. All other areas will see scattered to occasional showers. Rainfall values between 10 to 25 mm within 24 hours.
