**WEATHER BRIEF for Thursday, 11 July 2024, from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana**

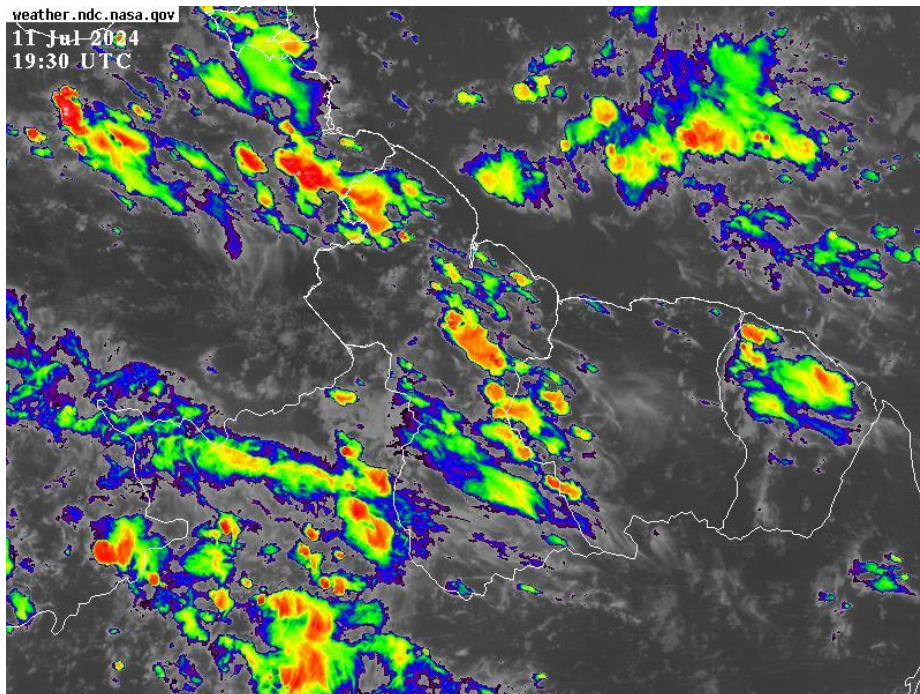
Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Thursday, July 11, 2024, were available for most stations. **Lethem in Region 9 recorded the highest rainfall of 60.3 mm.**

**Synopsis:** The high pressure ridge and subsidence produced stable conditions over most of Guyana. However, due to daytime heating, weak instabilities were seen over part of the forecast area.

**Today's weather review:** Northern Guyana saw partly cloudy to cloudy skies during the morning with passing showers. Conditions improved during the afternoon hours with skies becoming partly cloudy. Southern Guyana saw cloudy skies with isolated light to moderate showers.

**Extended Forecast**

**Saturday: Cloudy to overcast skies can be expected across Guyana with showers of varying intensities, intermittent rain, and isolated thundershowers. *Rainfall is expected between 25.0 mm and 50.0 mm.***

**Sunday thru Wednesday: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies can be expected over coastal areas with isolated showers during the morning hours. All other areas may experience cloudy skies with scattered showers and isolated thundershowers. *Rainfall is expected to be between 0.0 mm and 15.0 mm over coastal areas and between 15.0 mm and 30.0 mm elsewhere.***
