### Weather Brief for Saturday, 13 July 2024 from the Hydrometeorological Service, Guyana

Rainfall records for the past 24 hours, measured at 08:00 hrs Saturday, 13 July 2024. Of those available, Georgetown Botanical Gardens in Region 4 recorded the highest rainfall of 8.2 mm.

Synopsis: The ITCZ is currently affecting Guyana.


<u>Today's weather review</u>: Cloudy to overcast skies were observed across Guyana with occasional to frequent showers and isolated thundershowers over northern Guyana. southern Guyana saw scattered showers.

The long-term daily average rainfall for Georgetown, for the next 10 days July 14 to July 23, 2024, is 8.1 mm per day.

#### Sea conditions:

Smooth to moderate in open waters with northeasterly swells reaching heights of 1.5 to 2.0 meters (3 to 6ft) and steady.

- These waves are likely to have periods of 7 and 8 seconds.
- Gentle to moderate northeast to easterly winds.

#### Extended Forecast

Monday: Early morning thundershowers and rain over coastal areas. All other areas will see scattered showers and isolated thundershowers in the afternoon. Rainfall is expected between 20 to 50 mm.

<u>Tuesday:</u> cloudy to overcast skies with thundershowers and rain from mid-morning to late afternoon. Rainfall is anticipated between 30 to 60 mm within 24 hours of accumulations.

<u>Wednesday and Thursday:</u> A mix of sunshine and clouds with scattered showers and isolated thundershowers. Rainfall is expected between 10 to 20 mm.

<u>Friday and Saturday</u>, sunny skies during the morning becoming cloudy in the afternoon with isolated thundershowers. Rainfall is anticipated between 0 to 15 mm within 24 hours of accumulations.
